The machine is to be used only for its prescribed purpose. Any other use is deemed to be a case of misuse. The user / operator and not the manufacturer will be liable for any damage or injuries of any kind caused as a result of misuse. Please note that our equipment has not been designed for use in commercial, trade or industrial applications. Our warranty will be voided if the machine is used in commercial, trade or industrial businesses or for equivalent purposes.

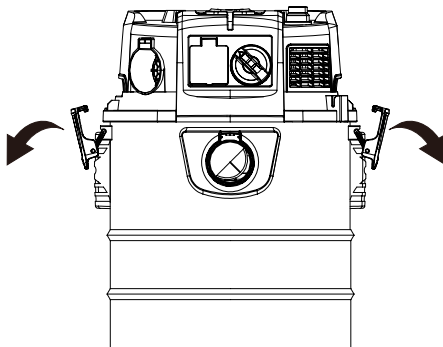

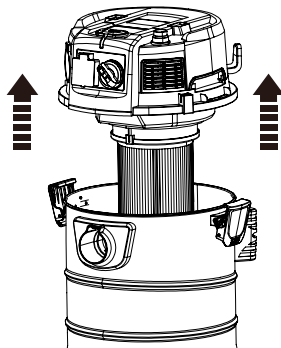
Before you connect the vacuum to a mains supply, make sure that the data on the rating/technical label is identical to the mains data.

Assembly instructions

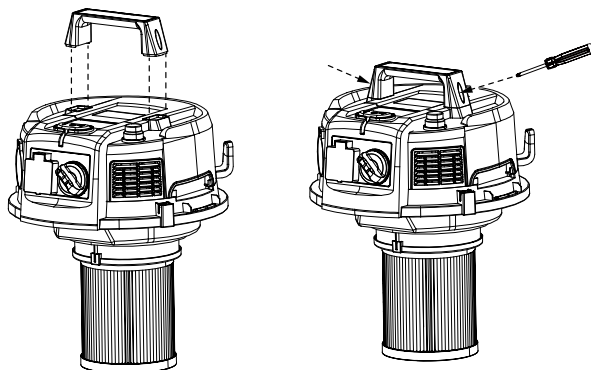
1. Unclamp latches(13).



2. Lift the power head off the container.

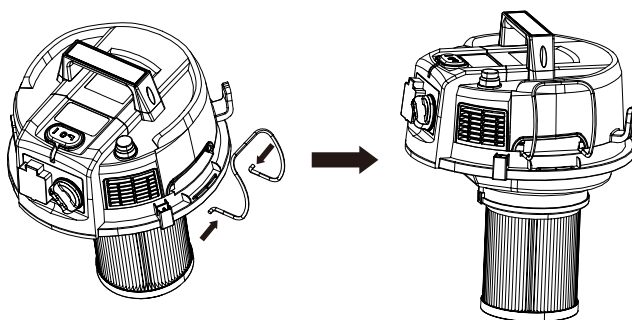


3. Remove all the contents from inside the container.
4. Drive in two screws with a screwdriver to install the carry handle(8).

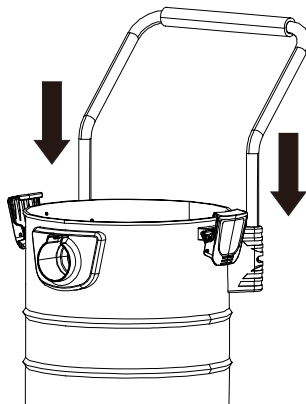


5. Squeeze the ends of the metal bracket(11). Put the metal bracket into the holder until both ends are sitting in the slots. Repeat the assembly on the other side.

Note: Install the 2 metal brackets to retain the flexible hose when the product is transported, stored or not in use.



6. Insert the push/pull handle(7) into the handle sockets mounted on either side of the collection tank. Push down until the lock pins click in place.



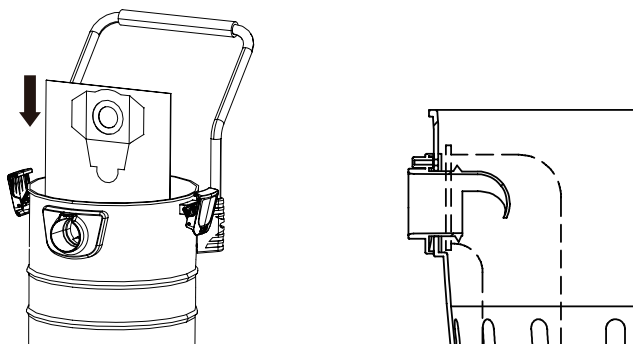
7. Attach non-woven dust bag (dry use only). Align the hole of the non-woven dust bag with the internal suction connector. Press down the non-woven dust bag to insert the internal suction connector into the hole of the non-woven dust bag until the seal ring is fitted into the circular rib.

NOTE: Not for blowing. Please see dry or wet operation for correct use of filter.



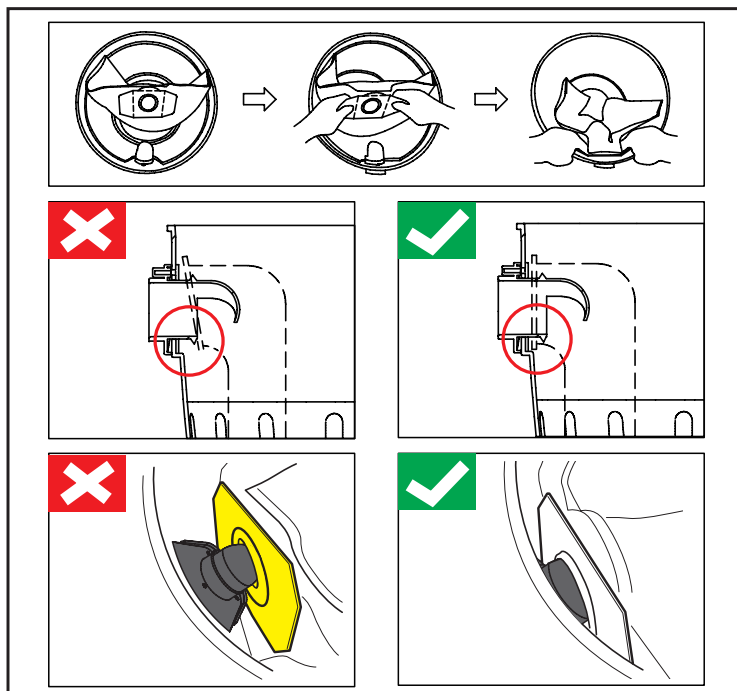

Assemble the **non-woven dust** bag incorrectly may cause dust leakage.

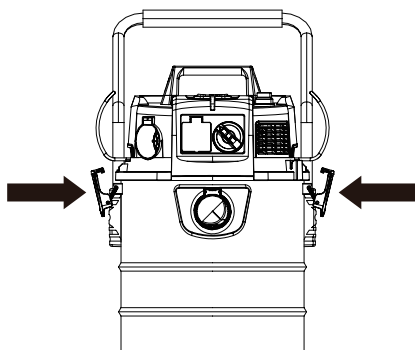

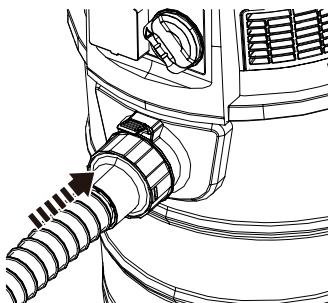
Take care when assembling the **non-woven dust** bag to avoid tearing. Incorrect fitting of the **non-woven dust** bag may result in a loss of suction. The **non-woven dust** bag is disposable.



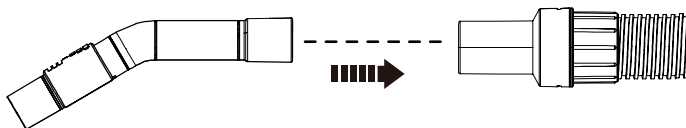
8. Place the power head back onto the container and secure it in place by clamping the latches shut.



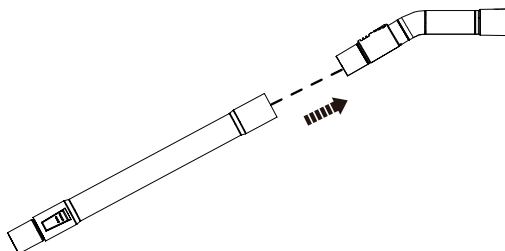
9. Align the hose coupler of the hose(3) with the vacuum connector. Push the hose coupler slowly into the vacuum connector gently until the lock button clicks into place. Check if the hose is connected properly by pulling the hose coupler.



10. Align the hose coupler of the hose to the curved handle. Push the hose coupler until the hose coupler is securely connected to the curved handle.



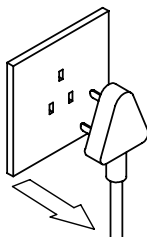
11. Align the curved handle to the telescopic tube(2). Push the curved handle until the coupler is securely connected to the tube.



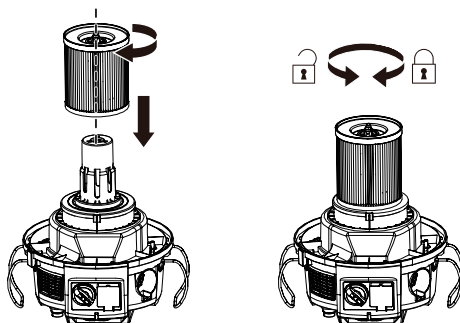
12. Attachments can be pushed onto the telescopic suction tube when required.

Dry vacuum operation

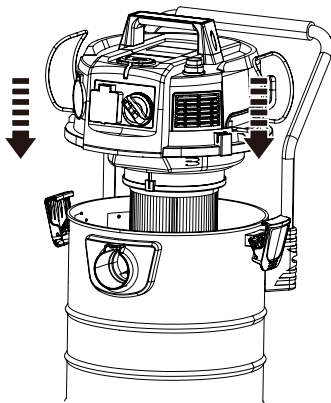
1. Ensure that the power cord is disconnected from the power outlet.



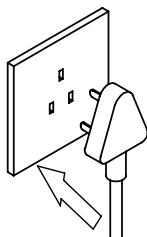
2. Remove the power head from the container as shown in the assembly instructions.
3. Firmly fit the **non-woven dust** bag (dry use only) as shown in the assembly instructions.
4. Fit the cartridge filter to the underside of the power head. Take care not to damage the cartridge filter. Rotate the filter lock clockwise to lock the filter in place.



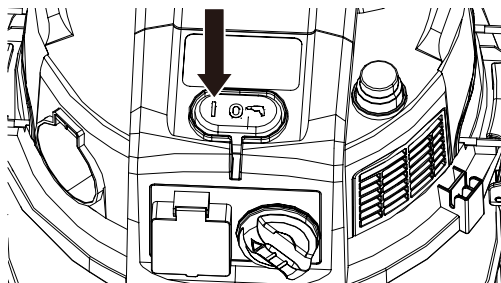
5. Place the power head back onto the container and lock the latch correctly.



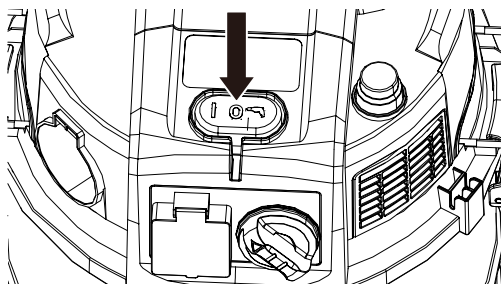
6. Connect the power cord to the power outlet.



7. Switch on the vacuum and proceed to clean. (I=ON)



8. Switch off the vacuum before emptying. (O=OFF)



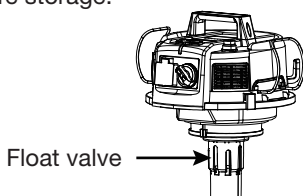
9. When emptying the container take care as this may be heavier than anticipated.
10. Clean filters and change if necessary.

Wet vacuum operation



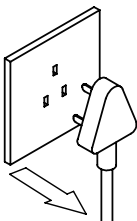
IMPORTANT

When vacuuming large volumes of liquid, do not immerse the nozzle completely in the liquid; leave a gap at the tip of the nozzle opening to allow for air inflow. The machine is fitted with a float valve that stops the suction when the container reaches its maximum capacity, and an increase in motor speed will be heard. When this happens, turn off the machine, disconnect from power supply and empty the liquid into a suitable receptacle or drain. To continue vacuuming, refit the power head to the container. After wet vacuuming, turn the machine off and remove plug from power supply. To prevent corrosion, empty the container, clean and dry the inside and outside of the container and remove the foam filter and allow to air dry before storage.

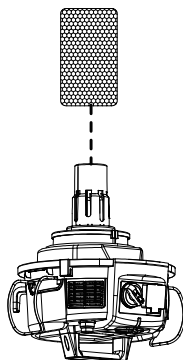


The float valve is a safety feature. Do not attempt to remove or modify this in any way. If the cleaner should overturn during wet operation, switch off immediately and return it to an upright position. Wait for the valve to reset before commencing cleaning.

1. Ensure that the power cord is disconnected from the power outlet.

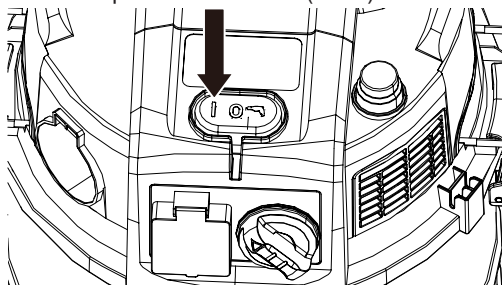


2. Remove the power head from the container as shown in the assembly instructions.
3. Fit the foam filter (wet use only) to the underside of the power head. Take care not to damage the filter.

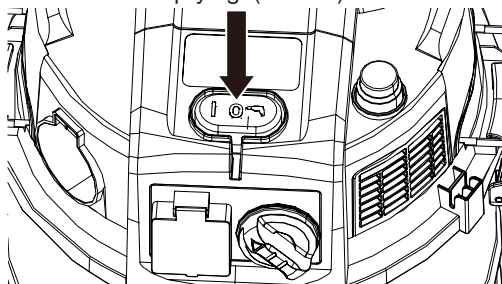


4. Put the power head back to the container and lock the latch correctly.

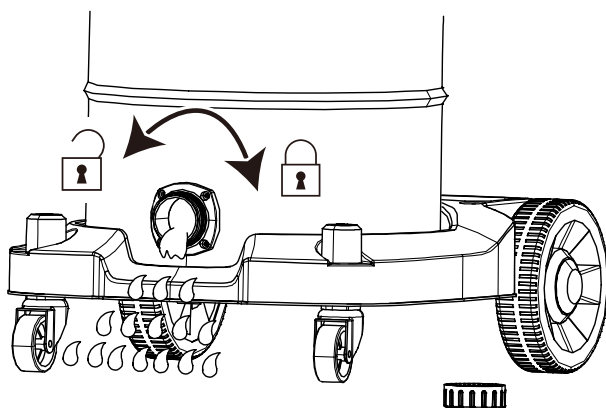
5. Switch on the vacuum and proceed to clean. (I=ON)



6. Switch off the vacuum before emptying. (O=OFF)



7. When emptying the container take care as this may be heavier than you think. You can also open the water outlet cover(15) to empty the tank.



8. Clean the tank and filter if necessary.

Cartridge Filter – For dry applications

Use the cartridge filter in position over the lid cage for most general dry material pick up.
Use the cartridge filter to collect particles that are not already caught by the dust bag.
Always assemble the cartridge filter onto the power head for dry vacuuming operations.
Operating the product without the cartridge filter can damage the motor unit.

Clean cartridge filter



WARNING!

Check the cartridge filter regularly for damage and deformation. A damaged or deformed filter can not be cleaned and must be replaced. This is necessary to maintain the functionality of the product and to protect the product from damage. Only use replacement filters from authorised resellers. Filters that are not compatible with the product can lead to injury and product damage.

Inspect the cartridge filter after each use.

Replace it with a new one if necessary.

Clean the cartridge filter:

- a) Before washing, give the filter a firm but even tap to dislodge large visible dust particles, reducing the burden of subsequent washing. Tap while slowly rotating the filter to ensure dust in all folds and crevices is dislodged. For particularly stubborn stains, gently scrub the surface with a soft brush first, then tap again.
- b) Rinse (from the inside of the filter) with clear water to wash the cartridge filter frequently and allow to dry completely. Do not wait until the filter is completely dirty.

We recommend inspecting the filter after each use. Clean the cartridge filter at least once a month to maintain optimal vacuum performance. Households with pets or allergies should clean every 1-2 weeks. For heavy usage or dusty environments, clean after each use.

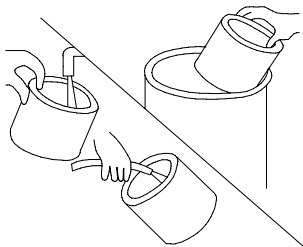
NOTE: Do not use chemical, alkaline, abrasive or other aggressive detergents or disinfectants to clean the dust bag and cartridge filter as they might be harmful to its surfaces/material.

Do not use a high-pressure water gun or hot water to avoid damaging the filter surfaces/material.

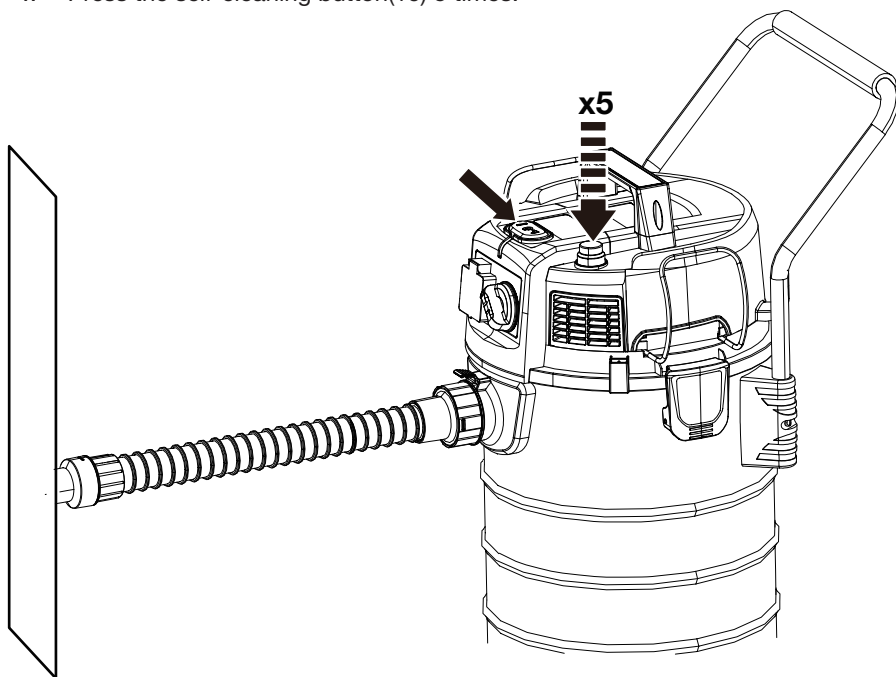
After rinsing, gently tap the outer surface of the filter to shake off residual dirt, then place it in a cool, ventilated area to air-dry completely (approximately 24 hours). Do not expose to direct sunlight or use artificial drying methods.

If there is stubborn dirt on the outer surface of the filter, first scrub the surface lightly with a soft-bristled brush, then rinse from the inside out.

After rinsing, gently tap the outer wall of the filter to help drain residual water and accelerate drying.



- c) The machine also is equipped with self-cleaning function. After each use, operate the machine as follows:
- Connect the mains plug to a suitable mains supply.
 - Set the on/off switch to position I.
 - Turn the airflow controller(5) to MAX position.
 - Block the hose outlet with a wall or the ground.
 - Press the self-cleaning button(10) 5 times.



WARNING: Firmly grip hose at all times. Sudden pressure buildup when blocking the outlet can cause violent hose whipping.

Foam filter for wet applications

Use the foam filter during wet vacuuming operations. Operating the product without the foam sleeve can damage the motor unit.

NOTE: Do not use chemical, alkaline, abrasive or other aggressive detergents or disinfectants to clean the foam filter as they might be harmful to its surfaces/material.

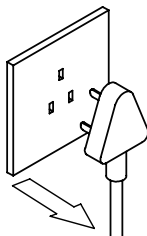
Inspect the foam filter regularly. Replace it with a new one if necessary. Wash the foam filter frequently, with clear water. Do not wait until the sleeve is completely dirty. We recommend inspecting the sleeve when the product does not reach a sufficient suction power.

BLOWING OPERATION

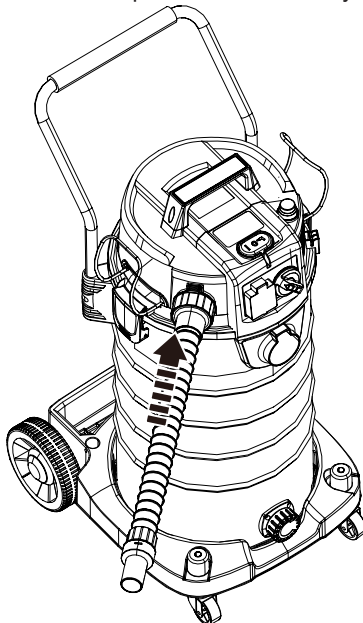
IMPORTANT!

Before commencing please ensure you have read and understood all the safety instructions.

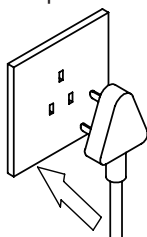
1. Ensure that the power cord is disconnected from the power outlet. No filter is required for blowing operations. Ensure that the container is completely empty before commencing.



2. Remove the hose from the vacuum port and insert firmly into the air outlet.

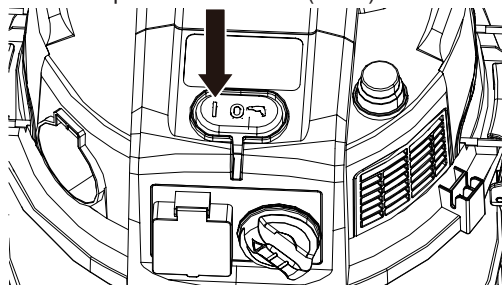


3. Select the most appropriate attachment for the task you wish to perform.
4. Connect the power cord to a suitable power outlet.

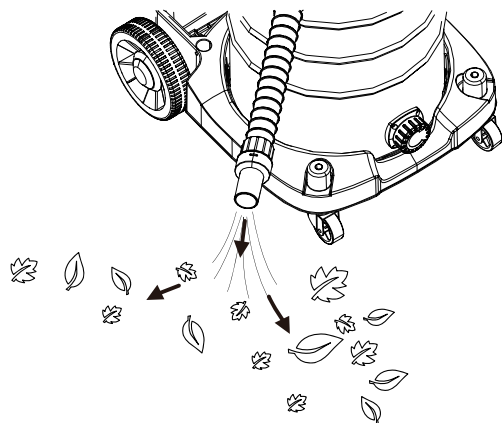


5. Before switching on, make sure you have a firm hold of the hose end.

6. Switch on the vacuum and proceed to clean. (I=ON)

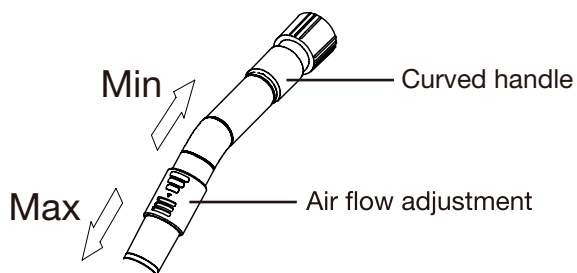


7. If blowing out dusty environments, always wear a suitable dust mask.
8. Protect eyes with suitable safety goggles and ensure no one else is nearby when operating.



VACUUM AND BLOW AIRFLOW ADJUSTMENT

The airflow can be controlled by setting the min / max adjustment switch(4) to the desired speed.



Power tool take off socket operation

This vacuum cleaner has a power take off feature which permits the cleaner to be coupled with a power tool, providing dust extraction.

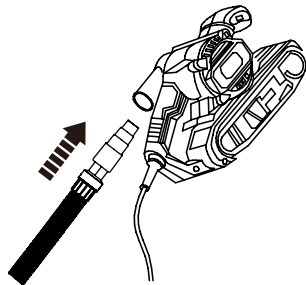
To operate the power take off feature align the hose adaptor with the hose if necessary, align the hose with the power tool, insert the plug of power tool into the socket(6) located in the lid of the cleaner. Once the plug is inserted, switch the vacuum cleaner on by using the  position.

The vacuum cleaner will now be operated in approx 1-2 second after power tool switch on. Please note that when the power tool is switched off, the vacuum cleaner will continue to run for approx 6-7 seconds. This ensures any debris is cleared from the pipe.

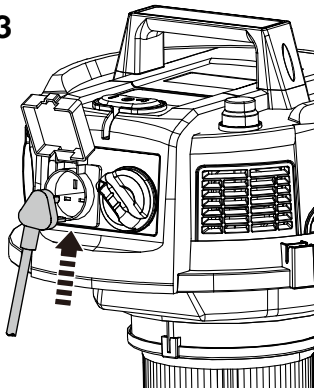

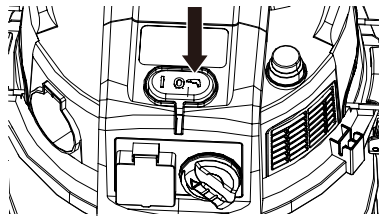

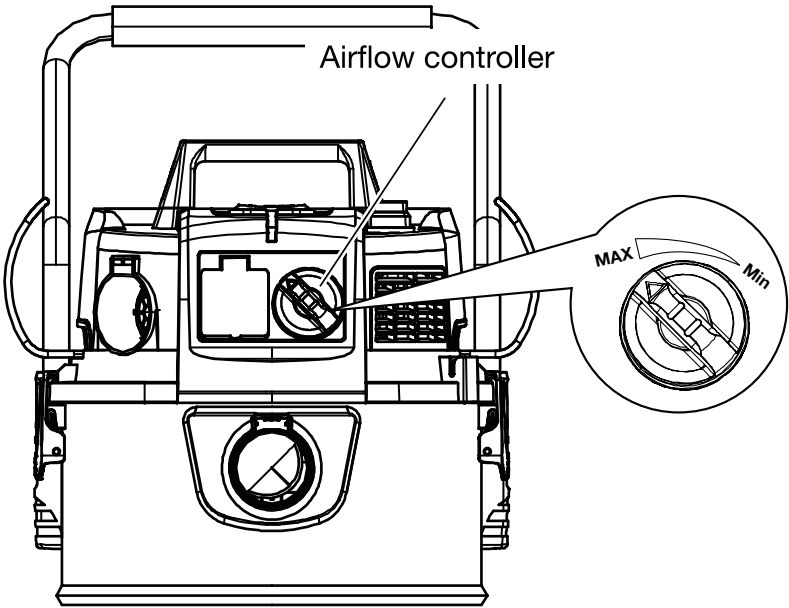
Do not plug any tool or appliance rated over the maximum wattage for the receptacle as noted in the chart above into the electrical socket on the vacuum cleaner.

To reduce the risk of injury, additional power tool must be turned (O) OFF before placing on/off switch in the  position. (NEVER LEAVE THE UNIT RUNNING OR PLUGGED IN UNATTENDED).

This vacuum cleaner is equipped with an airflow controller. Turn the airflow controller to adjust the airflow.

CARE AND CLEANING



IMPORTANT:

Make sure that the tool has been thoroughly cleaned before storing it in a clean, dry and safe place, out of the reach of children.

Remove the plug from the power outlet before commencing any maintenance.

After wet vacuuming, always empty, rinse and dry the container, hose and attachments. If vacuuming sticky spills, clean the tank and attachments with warm soapy water.

The foam filter can be cleaned using soapy water. Rinse and air dry for at least 24 hours. Take care when cleaning as small wood, metal or glass particles could get trapped in this filter. Check airways on hose and attachments to ensure there are no blockages.

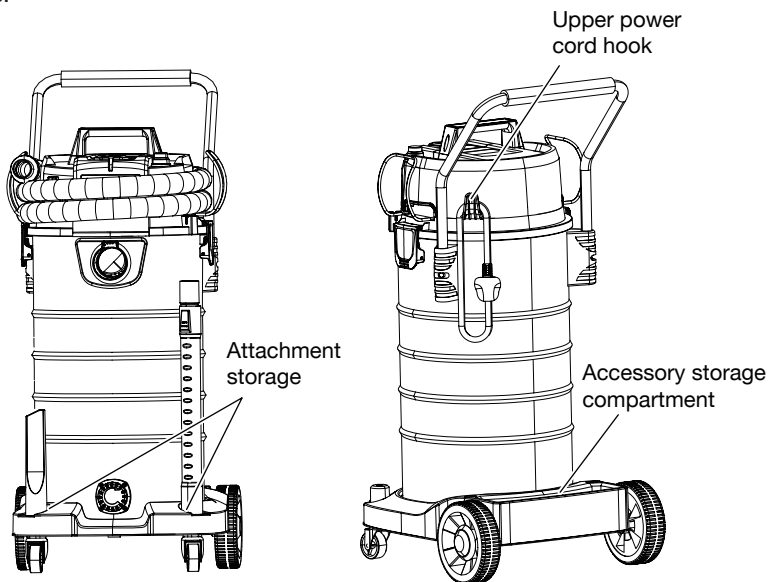
Never use chemical cleaners or an abrasive cloth to clean the vacuum, use a mild detergent and warm water. Dry with a soft dry cloth.

Do not oil the motor.

Store in a dry place.
