WARNING Do not direct the jet against yourself or others in order to clean clothes or foot-wear.

WARNING High pressure cleaners shall not be used by children or untrained personnel.

WARNING High pressure hoses, fittings and couplings are important for the safety of the machine. Use only hoses, fittings and couplings recommended by the manufacturer.

WARNING To ensure machine safety, use

only original spare parts from the manufacturer or approved by the manufacturer.

WARNING Water that has flowed through backflow preventers is considered to be non-potable.

WARNING Do not use the machine if a supply cord or important parts of the machine are damaged, e.g. safety devices, high pressure hoses, trigger gun.

OPERATING SAFETY

WARNING!

For safety reasons, high pressure hoses, valves and couplings must be used with unit. The new hosesets supplied with the appliance are to be used. Old hose-sets should not be reused. Please read these instructions fully before operating or maintaining your machine

OPERATING SAFETY

- High-pressure hose fittings and couplings are important for the safety of the appliance. Use only hose fittings and couplings supplied by the manufacturer.
- Inadequate extension cords can be dangerous. If an extension cord is used, it should be suitable for outdoor use, and be kept dry and off the ground. It is recommended that this is accomplished by means of a cord reel which keeps the socket at least 60 mm above the ground.
- The electric supply connection shall be made by a qualified electrician and comply with IEC 60364-1. It is recommended that the electric supply to this machine should include either a residual current device that will interrupt the supply if the leakage current to earth exceeds 30 mA for 30 ms or a

device that will prove the earth circuit.

- Disconnect from the electrical power supply before carrying out user maintenance.
- Do not use the machine if a supply cord or important parts of the machine are damaged, e.g. safety devices, high pressure hoses, trigger gun.
- If extension cable is used, the plug and socket outlet must be of a watertight construction.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- The PVC or polychloroprene sheathed power cord or extension cables (H05VV-F) are acceptable for use at temperatures at or above 0°C.

Never carry the appliance by the cable or the hose. Do not carry the equipment with your finger on the On/Off switch when it is connected to the mains.

WARNING

Remove plug from socket:

- When you are not using the equipment.
- When transporting equipment.
- When left unattended.
- When checking or cleaning equipment.
- When removing blockages or performing maintenance or changing accessories.
- When cable is damaged.
- After contact with foreign bodies.
- If the machine begins to vibrate abnormally.
- Do not use the appliance near flammable liquids or gases. In case of nonobservance, there is a risk of fire or explosion.
- Ensure that the mains

voltage matches the information on the label.

- Before each use check the equipment, power cable and plug for damage, to avoid an electrical shock.
- Damaged cables, coupling and plugs or connecting leads that are not compliant with specifications are not to be used. Remove the plug from the plug socket immediately in case of damage or cutting through of the mains cable.
- Do not use the equipment when the switching action of the On/Off switch is impaired. Have damaged switches replaced at our Service Centre.
- Do not overload your appliance. Work only within the indicated range of performance. For heavy work, do not use a machine with insufficient power. Do not use your appliance for purposes other than those specified.

WARNING!

- Retrofitting or making any unauthorised changes to the machine, as well as the use of unapproved parts will invalidate your warranty.

- Store the appliance in a dry location and out of reach of children.
- Handle the appliance with care. Keep the equipment clean for safe and more efficient working. Follow the maintenance directions.
- The appliance may be damaged by frost. There is always residual water left inside the highpressure washer and in the pump. Do not store the machine at temperatures below freezing point.

- To clean machines, vehicles, buildings, tools, facades, terraces, garden equipment etc. using a high-pressure water jet (and detergents if required).
- To use with accessories, replacement parts and detergents approved by Spear & Jackson.
- Observe the instructions provided with these detergents.
- Any use of the machine that deviates from its intended use and is not included in these instructions is considered unauthorised use and relieves the manufacturer from his or her legal liability.


ATTENTION!

Through poor conditions of the electrical MAINS, shortly voltage drops can appear when starting the EQUIPMENT. This can influence other equipment (eg. Blinking of a lamp). If the MAINS-IMPEDANCE Zmax<0.444 OHM, such disturbances are not expected. (In case of need, you may contact your local supply authority for further information).

WARNING - Pull out the power plug before carrying out any work on the equipment, and use only original parts. Before starting any cleaning task, it is important to inspect the area for objects that could create a hazard. Remove any objects from the work area that could be tripped over, such as toys or outdoor furniture. Ensure that all doors and windows are closed tightly.


Connecting the hose and spray gun.

Screw the high pressure hose (3) firmly onto the spray gun (10).




Fit the lance to spray gun.

Insert the adjustable spray lance (9) or turbo lance (8) to spray gun (10), and twist 1/4 turn to lock in position.



3 Connecting garden hose to water supply.


Attach garden hose (not included) to the non-potable water supply and turn water on until a steady flow of water runs out of the hose. Turn the water off.



ASSEMBLY

Connecting garden hose and inlet connector.

Attach a hose with a quick connect coupling (not included) to the high pressure washer.






Make sure the ON/OFF switch is in the OFF position.

7 Connecting to socket.

Insert the mains plug into the socket.

8 Telescopic handle

Push the button on side, and uplift the handle.

9 Hose Reel

Befor using, release the hose to proper length.

OPERATION

WARNING - Wear suitable clothing, ear and eye protection when working with the equipment. Ensure that the mains voltage value matches the label on the equipment.

Before starting

- i. Check the machine for visual defects.
- li. Check that all parts of the machine have been securely fitted.
- ili. Check if the water connector and the high-pressure hose are tight.



Starting

- i. Put the high pressure washer on level ground. Stand in a secure and stable position.
- li. Open the water supply.
- ili. Unlock the safety trigger on the spray gun and press the trigger until there is a steady stream of water.
- iv. Set the On/Off switch to ON.




Stopping

- i. Release the trigger, and engage the safety lock.
- ii. Set the On/Off switch to OFF.
- iii. Close water supply.

ATTENTION! Risk of machine damage!

Never operate the machine without the water being connected as dry running may damage the pump. Use a water filter if the inlet water is contaminated.





OPERATION

RISK OF FATAL INJURY!

Use special care when cleaning tyres. Vehicle tyres/ tyre valves may become damaged or burst when handled improperly. First signs of damage included discolourations on the tyre. Damaged vehicle tyres/ tyre valves pose a life-threatening risk. Keep the jet at a distance of at least 30 cm!

The high-pressure jet may be dangerous when handled improperly. The jet may not be directed towards living beings (persons, animals), live equipment or the machine itself.

High pressure working

- i. Switch on the high pressure washer and hold the handheld spray gun firmly with both hands.
- ii. Unlock the safety button and press the trigger on the handheld spray gun.
- iii. The high-pressure pump starts running as soon as you operate the hand-held spray gun.
- iv. The high-pressure pump stops running as soon as you release the trigger on the hand-held spray gun.

Note: Always test the surface in a small and discreet place before cleaning. Pressure washing can strip paint from surfaces and/or leave some surfaces damaged.

Using with adjustable spray lance

Ideal for lighter cleaning tasks like cars, bikes, patios and furniture.


The adjustable spray lance has a 180 degree rotation nozzle to adjust the width of the spray and as such the pressure on the surface.

To adjust the spray, turn the nozzle into the desired direction as shown on the nozzle.

It takes a couple of seconds for the spray to adjust to the new setting.



CAUTION! Jet spray adjustment is very aggressive. Do not adjust while spraying. Switch the machine off when interrupting your work for extended periods of time.



OPERATION

Using the turbo lance

Ideal for stubborn dirt, painted wood and PVC windows, conservatories and furniture.

The turbo lance is designed to have less impact on the surface as the spray rotates around.

Note: Before you clean, always test the impact of the pressure washer on the surface on a non-prominent place.

i. Stop the machine.


- ii. Change the adjustable spray lance with turbo lance.
- iii. Test the lance on the surface in non intrusive place.

Using the patio cleaner


Ideal for cleaning areas without the splash-back of dirt like patios, fences, garage doors, gravel and pebbled pathways.


Stop the machine before changing the lance for the extension pole and patio cleaner.

To clean the patio make side ways movements, instead of up and down scrubbing movements.





Using the fixed brush and rotary brush

Ideal for cleaning delicate surfaces, like vehicles and paint work, as the fixed brush is a low pressure accessory. Stop the machine before attaching the brush to the spray gun.



OPERATION

Using the detergent bottle

Special pressure washer detergents can be used to increase the cleaning power of the pressure washer.

Detergent can only be used with low pressure attachments like the adjustable lance in low pressure setting, the rotary brush and the fixed brush.

- i. Make sure the machine is turned off and engage the safety lock on the spray gun, before filling the detergent bottle.
- ii. Unscrew the lid from the bottle and fill with detergent diluted according to the fluid instructions.

iii. Screw the lid.

iv. Pull the adjustable lance nozzle forward, configuring the machine to low pressure.

Note:


- The lance has to be set to low pressure for the machine to engage when using detergent.
- Allow detergent to remain on the surface for a short time before rinsing. Do not allow detergent to dry on surface
- Before you change the type of detergent for another job, rinse the detergent tank with clean water.
 Pull the trigger on the lance at low pressure for one minute until all all detergent is flushed through the system.

Use with water butt or reservoir

The machine can also operate with water from sources other than a water tap, e. g. ponds and water butts. The use of an additional water filter (not supplied) is highly recommended for this kind of use.

Make sure the water source is situated no more than 1m below the level of the machine. The water inlet hose must not be too long, approx. 3 m. Fill water supply hose (not supplied) with water before connecting it to the machine.

Running the machine without water (running dry) will damage it. Run machine without lance attached until there is a constant flow of water.



MAINTENANCE

Turn off machine and connect lance.

Note: The internal mesh filter of the machine is not intended for the filtration of large quantities of impurities.

Overview of cleaning

- After every use wipe the machine with a slightly damp cloth. Do not clean the machine using a high-pressure water jet.
- Clean the high-pressure jet nozzle.

The pressure washer is equipped with a water filter inlet adapter to protect the pump. If the filter is not kept clean, the water flow to the machine will be restricted and the pump may be damaged.

To clean water filter, remove inlet adapter and get the filter out.

- Rinse filter until it is free of debris and blockage.
- Replace the filter and inlet adapter.

Note: Keep the nozzle pin out of children's reach.

Cleaning limescale

Over time limescale may build up on your lance outlet, use the nozzle cleaning pin to remove this.


Storing


Store the machine where it is dry and well ventilated. When placing the machine out of service for an extended period of time, remove the cleaning agent and drain all the water left in the hoses.

Always empty water from all hoses before storing.

Hold the hose, then turn the hose reel handle, make sure the hose is rolled in a straight line and without kinking the hose.

Click the cable clip on hose.

Transport

If shipping, use the original packaging wherever possible.

Disposal

Disposing of the machine

Machines which are labelled with the this symbol must not be disposed of in household rubbish. You must dispose of such old electrical and electronic appliances separately. 4. Great pressure variances	Check if the nozzle is blocked.Inlet water is blocked.	 Clean the high pressure jet noz- zle with the nozzle pin provided. Make sure the inlet hose is not twisted or kinked.
5. Machine is leaking	Sealing parts are broken.	Please contact the after sales support at 0345 605 2067.

In such cases, the work performed or parts fitted will not result in an extension of the warranty period, and no new warranty will become active for the work performed or parts fitted.
