## ELECTRICAL SAFETY

### 1. SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING!** Read all instructions. Failure to follow all instructions listed below may result in serious injury. This product should never be left unattended when connected to the mains supply.

#### Power source

Your wallpaper stripper requires a 230-240V AC 50Hz supply. Do not use any other supply.

### Using the wallpaper stripper

- a) This product is designed for household use involving steam cleaning tasks and wallpaper stripping in and around the home. Industrial or commercial use will invalidate the warranty.
- b) Keep children and visitors away from the wallpaper stripper. Do not let children use the wallpaper stripper.
- c) Never handle the mains plug or water tank with wet hands.
- d) Do not leave the water tank unattended when heating up, during use or when cooling down.
- e) Use only the manufacturer's tools and accessories.
- f) Do not use the wallpaper stripper if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or immersed in water.
- g) Do not carry or pull the water tank by the power cable.
- h) Do not put any objects in openings in the accessories.
- i) When not in use, store in a cool dry area indoors. Do not store near heat sources as this may damage the casing.
- j) Use in a well lit area.
- k) Never turn the tank over or on its side during use.
- l) Never direct steam towards people, pets, plants, and equipment with electrical components such as the interior of ovens.
- m) Do not immerse the water tank in water or any other liquid. Do not remove the safety cap during use. Always allow the water tank to cool down before attempting removal of the safety cap.
- n) Never put descaling, aromatic, alcoholic or detergent products into the water tank, as this can damage it or make it unsafe for use.
- o) The Steam plates and hose will get hot during use. Allow the tools to cool down before changing them while the water tank is being used.
- p) Beware of dripping water when used overhead.
- q) Do not lay the steam plate and steam nozzle down or leave unattended while steam is being generated, especially when

children and pets are present.

- r) Do not use steam on cold glass as the glass may be damaged.
- s) Do not use outside in adverse weather conditions or allow the water tank to be exposed to rain or moisture. The use of a 30mA high sensitivity residual circuit breaker (RCD) is recommended for outdoor use or around the home.
- t) If the water tank is used with an extension lead, make sure that the lead is rated for at least 10A and includes the provision of a protective earthing conductor. Always take care when using extension leads to avoid creating a hazard.
- u) Do not use the wallpaper stripper if the mains lead or plug are damaged. Refer to qualified personnel.

### Service

- a) **Have your power tool serviced by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts.** This will ensure that the safety of the power tool is maintained.

### APPLICATION

#### Intended use

The steam wallpaper stripper is intended for removal of wallpaper at home. Any other use or modification to the device shall be considered as improper use and could give rise to considerable dangers. The manufacturer will not accept liability for loss or damage arising from improper use. The device is not intended for commercial use.

### **Check the delivery parts**

Carefully remove the machine from its packaging and check as the following parts are complete:

Operating instruction

### **Product Features**

The numbering of the product features refers to the illustration of the machine on the graphics page (pic. A)

1. Steam valve
2. Air hose
3. Steam plate
4. Container

### **Before Operation**

The mains voltage at the mains socket must match that shown on the rating plate on the device.

To achieve fastest paper removal always gently score the areas to be stripped.

With heavily embossed, vinyl coated or painted papers this is essential. Either use a proprietary perforator tool or alternatively score the paper with the edge of a wall scraper in a criss-cross pattern with 150mm( 6 inch)

spacing.

As with all decorating work be sure to protect carpets and furniture with covers.

### **Filling the container(Pic.B)**

The container has a capacity of 4.5 litres. Fill the tank as follows:

- a) Check that the mains supply is disconnected.
- b) Unscrew the steam valve.
- c) Make sure that the container is on a stable flat surface.
- d) Pour water, preferably hot, into the container.  
Distilled water is not necessary.
- e) Fill the container to the MAX level for the longest steaming time. For a shorter steaming time use less water, but do not fill to less than the MIN level.
- f) Screw steam valve back onto the container and tighten by hand.
- g) Connect the hose to container by screwing the captive nut on the hose in a clockwise direction until it is tight.



### **Switching On and Off**

Put the plug into the socket and the stripper starts working.

To switch off, just pull the plug from the socket.

### **Fitting the steam plates(Pic. C) this should be done before switching On and Off**

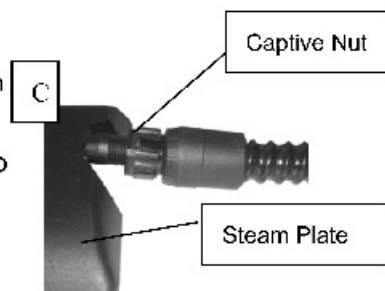
- a) The steam plate is connected to the container via a flexible hose.  
Screw the captive nut, in a clockwise direction, onto the steam plate until it is tight.

**WARNING!** Do not leave unattended during the heating-up period.

**WARNING!** The steam plates and hose get hot during use.

Allow the steam plates and hose to cool down before touching them.

b) Connect the other end of the steam hose to the container.



### **Removing the tools**

#### **First switch off the steamer and allow to cool**

To disconnect the steam plate from the steam hose, unscrew the captive nut on the steam hose in an anticlockwise direction, until the tool is released.

### **Wallpaper stripping**

To achieve the fastest paper removal:

- a) Gently score the areas to be stripped. (With heavily embossed, vinyl coated or painted paper this is essential).
- b) Either use a proprietary perforator tool or alternatively score the paper with the edge of a wallpaper scraper in a criss-cross pattern with a spacing of approximately 150mm (6").
- c) Hold the steam plate flat against the wall for approximately 10 seconds.
- d) Move the steam plate to the area immediately beside the one just steamed and use a wallpaper scraper to remove the paper from the steamed area.
- e) Operate until the water level reaches the MIN mark on the water tank, then unplug the water tank and allow it to cool for at least 5 minutes before removing the filler cap.

### **Refilling the container while wallpaper stripping**

Should the need arise to refill the container with water while wallpaper stripping:

- a) Unplug the power cable from the mains supply socket.

- b) Wait at least 5 minutes for the water tank to cool, then carefully start to unscrew the safety valve. If you hear steam escaping, stop and wait until the hissing sound stops.
- c) Carefully continue to unscrew the safety valve. If you hear steam escaping again, stop and wait for the hissing to stop.
- d) Continue in this manner until the safety cap can be removed. Take great care, as any residual water is very hot.
- e) Slowly fill the water tank with water using a funnel. See page 11.
- f) Screw the safety cap back onto the steamer and tighten by hand.
- g) Plug the 3-pin mains plug into the mains socket and switch on.
- h) Continue with the instructions for switching on .

### **Safety cut-out**

A safety cut-out is fitted to prevent overheating of the element if the water boils low. If the container stops boiling, this can be the cause.

- a) Wait two minutes before removing the filler cap then refill with water.
- b) The cut-out will reset itself and steam will be produced within 15 minutes.

### **MAINTENANCE**

#### **Before each use:**

Check that the safety valve in the filler cap moves freely when lightly pressed from the underside.

Cleaning

After each use:

- a) Empty any remaining water from the water tank.
- b) Wipe the body of the water tank with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- c) Store the water tank and accessories in a dry, cool place.

### **SERVICE AND REPAIR**

Should the wallpaper stripper require repair during the guarantee period, please return it to the place of purchase. You will need to provide proof of purchase to obtain a free of charge repair or replacement.

Do not dispose of electrical appliances with your domestic waste!

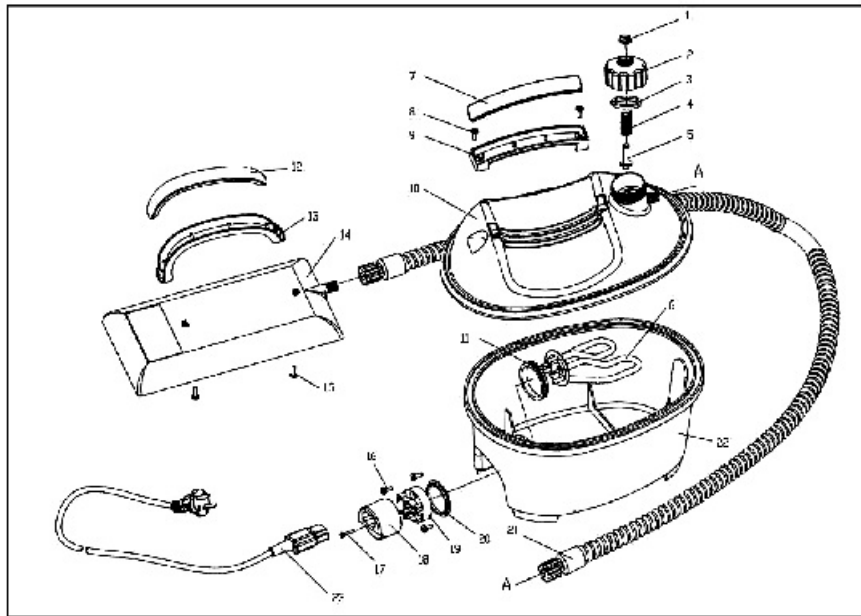
